

Hello from the LRG!

Below is the information we know many of you have been waiting for since we first announced our intention to host a European tournament last year.

Firstly, **the registration process** is as follows:



Leagues wishing to enter a travel team(s) will need to complete a registration form for each team and submit a hard copy, signed by an authorised league representative. This should be accompanied by a cheque for the registration/entry fee. Payment can also be made by BACS transfer. Contact payments@londonrollergirls.com for account details. Registration will not be considered complete until payment is received.

Teams formed of skaters from multiple leagues must do the same, however have an authorised team representative from each participating league sign the application form. To qualify to register a team of skaters from multiple leagues, participating skaters' leagues must not be entering a travel team.

Leagues can submit more than one travel team. Please designate your teams as Team 1 and Team 2. Priority on available slots for each league team will go to Team 1 applicants before we fill up with Team 2's. We want as many different leagues as possible to be able to participate in the tournament, however **we are operating on a first come first served basis.**

Once registration has closed, successful applicant leagues/teams will receive written confirmation of a slot allocation.

The tournament will be played using the current WFTDA Standardized Flat Track Rollerderby Rules as at 20th June 2009 (4 weeks before the tournament). Any new ruleset featuring major changes published within 4 weeks of Roll Britannia is unlikely to be adopted. This is to ensure a high quality of game knowledge by skaters, and high quality refereeing. The exception will be that some games (such as consolation games, or early group stage games) may be shorter than standard WFTDA game length).

Teams:

Please note the following Team Information from the ruleset:

- 1.1 Teams shall consist of a maximum of 20 skaters that have passed the standard eligibility requirements established by the Women's Flat Track Derby Association (WFTDA).
- 1.2 At most, 14 skaters may be on the roster for a specific game. Leagues may rotate their game roster from their team roster between games.
- 1.3 During a tournament, leagues may substitute alternates from their team roster. If a skater is pulled from the tournament and replaced with an alternate, she cannot re-enter the tournament in a subsequent game. (Not applicable to ejections, see *Section 6.5.2.4.*)
- 1.4 A league may have more than one team.

Roll Britannia Information Pack and Registration/Roster Submission Forms.

Skaters may only be registered on one (1) team, and **MUST** be at least 18 years of age, female, and a skating member of an active European league. 'Guest Skaters' are not permitted on league teams. Leagues wishing to submit a team using guest skaters must apply to enter a mixed team.

The team roster **does not** need to be submitted with the registration form; the team rosters will need to be submitted at least 6 weeks before the tournament, and changes to the 20-skater roster will be permitted up to 4 weeks from the Tournament (see timeline for roster deadline below).

Uniforms:

Each team will be required to have two (2) jersey colours: one light and one dark. This is to ensure that there is high contrast between teams.

Registration/Entry Fee:

There is a non-refundable registration/entry fee of £200 per team. Should a team not be able to participate due to getting an application in late, or slot unavailability, then the fee will be refunded. We are operating on a first come, first served basis, and there are a limited number of slots available. We can only fit so many games into 2 days!

Insurance:

Public Indemnity Insurance is in place for Roll Britannia, however all participants (skaters, referee's, officials, volunteers) are responsible for their own personal medical/injury insurance. Personal medical/injury insurance is not a requirement for participation. All participants take part at their own risk and will be required to sign a liability waiver and provide emergency contact information before participating. The London Rollergirls and Roll Britannia accepts no liability for any injuries or loss or damage of property.

Fighting/Bringing the game into disrepute:

London Rollergirls believes that there is no place for fighting in the sport of roller derby. All teams agree that their players and support crew will not engage in any fighting or physical attacks on other players or support crew, neither "play" nor serious, during any bouts. Any attempt at fighting may result in immediate ejection of the participating skaters from the current bout and additional suspensions during the tournament. The decision of the Head Referee is final. The league contact is responsible for conveying this agreement explicitly to all league members.

Timelines:

Registration Deadline:	20 th March 2009
Confirmation of Acceptance:	29 th March 2009
Deadline for Submission of Team Roster:	5 th June 2009
Deadline for Submission of Roster Changes:	19 th June 2009
Roll Britannia:	18 th & 19 th July 2009

Team/League Imagery:

All participating teams permit the London Rollergirls to use their team/league logos in print and online media for the purpose of promoting Roll Britannia (including but not limited to tournament programs, post tournament write-ups, and re-caps).



Once you submit your roster by 6th June, there is a two-week period during which time you may make changes.

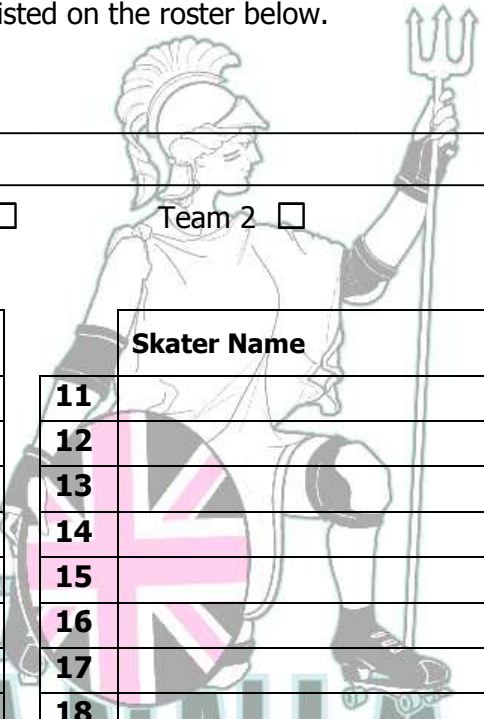
After 20th June 2009, the only substitutions permitted will be to your starting 14 for each game, which must take place between games, and no substitutions are allowed during actual game play.
